



TSL moves HD to Kuwait: The first HDTV facility in Kuwait will be built by TSL, writes Adrian Pennington. The systems integrator has signed a deal to design, supply and integrate a complete HDTV facility on behalf of broadcaster Alwatan TV (owned by Dar Alwatan), which will be split between two sites in Kuwait city. The main site will house the largest TV studio in the Middle East and a second smaller space, which will contain the HD studios, MCR and two channels of HD playout.
